## **1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 896**

March 10, 1998 – Introduced by Representative TRAVIS. Referred to Joint survey committee on Tax Exemptions.

1 AN ACT to create 70.11 (32m) of the statutes; relating to: creating a property

tax exemption for the property of little leagues.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 70.11 (32m) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 70.11 (**32m**) LITTLE LEAGUES. Property owned by a little league that is affiliated
- 5 with Little League Baseball of Williamsport, Pennsylvania.
- 6 SECTION 2. Effective date.
- 7 (1) This act takes effect on January 1, 1999.
