March 26, 1998 – Introduced by Representatives GROTHMAN and SERATTI, cosponsored by Senators Welch, Huelsman and Roessler. Referred to Joint survey committee on Tax Exemptions.

1 AN ACT to create 77.54 (44) of the statutes; relating to: a sales tax and use tax

exemption for coinage, bullion and similar goods.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales tax and use tax exemption for legal tender, currency, medallions and gold or silver coinage issued by this state, the United States or a foreign country, and for bullion.

This bill will be referred to the joint survey committee on tax exemptions for a detailed analysis, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 77.54 (44) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 77.54 (44) The gross receipts from the sale of and the storage, use or other

5 consumption of legal tender, currency, medallions and gold or silver coinage if those

- 6 goods are issued by this state, the United States or a foreign country, and for bullion.
- 7 SECTION 2. Effective date.
