

1997 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 10

January 21, 1997 – Introduced by Representative Albers, cosponsored by Senator Schultz. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1	Relating to: the life and public service of Oscar Laper.
2	Whereas, Oscar Laper was born on July 13, 1915, in Green Lake county and
3	died on September 29, 1996, in Baraboo; and
4	Whereas, he graduated from Markesan High School and completed the
5	Commercial Course at Northwestern College in Watertown; and
6	Whereas, Mr. Laper served on the board of the Town of Excelsior for 40 years,
7	including 15 years of service as chair, and on the board of supervisors of Sauk County
8	for 40 years and was the Midwest Director of the National Association of Soil and
9	Water Conservation Districts; and
10	Whereas, he served in the assembly from 1967 to 1971 as a Republican
11	representing Sauk County; and
12	Whereas, during his tenure in the assembly he served diligently on the
13	Education Committee, the Labor Committee and the Taxation Committee; and
14	Whereas, Mr. Laper was also a skilled organist and played that instrument
15	professionally; now, therefore, be it
16	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the members of the
17	legislature of the state of Wisconsin commend Oscar Laper's many years of public

- service, express their sorrow at his death and extend their condolences to his family and friends; and, be it further
- Resolved, That the assembly chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint
 resolution to Mr. Laper's wife, Lois, and to his daughter, Myrna Armstrong.
