- 6 Whereas, Ms. Karyn Bye, a forward for the team, is the alternate captain of the
- 7 Gold-Medal winning Olympic team and a 5-time member of the United States
- 8 Women's National Hockey Team; and
- 9 Whereas, Karyn Bye, who played in all 6 Olympic games for the United States,
- 10 led the team with 5 goals and 3 assists and was a chief contributor to the team going
- 11 undefeated throughout Olympic play and beating Canada 3 to 1 in the final game for
- 12 the Gold Medal; and
