Relating to: petitioning the federal government to support the recommendations of 1 2 Representative Klug's task force on the Badger Army Ammunition Plant. 3 Whereas, the future use of the Badger Army Ammunition Plant, which is 4 located between Baraboo and Sauk City, is an important issue; and 5 Whereas, Representative Scott Klug has headed a task force on that subject; 6 and 7 Whereas, that task force recommended that aids in lieu of taxes be paid on that 8 property, that federal support for environmental remediation and the removal of 9 unsafe structures be continued, that contracts that authorize use of part of that 10 property and the railroad line be continued, that adverse effects on the owners of 11 adjacent land be avoided, that the land be used in a number of compatible ways and

Whereas, the task force's recommendations are sensitive to the needs of the area in and around the plant and are rational; now, therefore, be it

that ownership and management of part of the land be transferred to this state; and
