

1997 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 19

February 3, 1997 – Introduced by Representatives MORRIS-TATUM, TURNER, COGGS, BOCK, RILEY, BALDWIN and L. YOUNG. Referred to Committee on Government Operations.

1 **Relating to:** establishing a sister-state relationship with the Cap Vert Region of $\mathbf{2}$ Senegal. Whereas, African American residents of Wisconsin are developing trade, 3 commerce and cultural ties with the Senegalese people; and 4 Whereas, Goree Island, which is located in the Cap Vert Region of Senegal, was $\mathbf{5}$ 6 the debarkation point for African slaves bound for American shores, which makes it 7 extremely likely that there are African Americans currently residing in Wisconsin 8 who are descendants of people from that region; and 9 Whereas, a sister-state relationship would benefit both Wisconsin and the Cap 10 Vert Region of Senegal by facilitating an exchange of information and ideas, by 11 promoting travel between the 2 regions and by increasing the number of exchange programs between them; now, therefore, be it 1213 **Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That:** the members of the Wisconsin legislature encourage this state's executive branch to establish a 14 15sister-state relationship between Wisconsin and the Cap Vert Region of Senegal. 16 (END)
