1	Relating to: requesting the U.S. Department of Agriculture to cease using the
2	National Cheese Exchange price in determining the basic formula price for
3	manufacturing milk.
4	Whereas, the current federal basic formula price for manufacturing milk is
5	greatly influenced by the National Cheese Exchange price for block and barrel
6	cheddar cheese; and
7	Whereas, the National Cheese Exchange price results from trading that
8	represents less than 2% of all bulk cheddar cheese sold nationally; and
9	Whereas, the National Cheese Exchange was never intended to be an indicator
10	of national supply of and demand for milk; and
11	Whereas, there are other measures that have the potential to be more reliable
12	indicators of market supply of and demand for milk; now, therefore, be it
13	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the members of the
14	Wisconsin legislature urge the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and Secretary
15	Daniel Glickman, to cease using the market activities of the National Cheese
16	Exchange in determining the basic formula price for manufacturing milk and to

instead establish a broad-based formula that more accurately represents market
 conditions for milk in establishing the basic formula price; and, be it further

Resolved, That the assembly chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint
resolution to Secretary Glickman and to each member of this state's congressional
delegation.
