

1997 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 53

May 6, 1997 – Introduced by Representative URBAN, cosponsored by Senators FARROW and MOORE. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1	Relating to: The life and public service of Stan Pelecky.
2	Whereas, Stan T. Pelecky was born on April 27, 1934, in Milwaukee, and died
3	on March 24, 1997; and
4	Whereas, After proceeding through the Milwaukee public schools, Mr. Pelecky
5	earned a B.S. degree in mathematics and physics from the University of
6	Wisconsin-Madison; and
7	Whereas, he served in the U.S. Army Signal Corps and as an attorney for the
8	32nd Infantry Division; and
9	Whereas, he was elected to the assembly in 1962; and
10	Whereas, during his term in the assembly Mr. Pelecky was a member of the
11	State Affairs Committee; and
12	Whereas, he also served as Representative Henry Reuss home secretary; now,
13	therefore, be it
14	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the members of the
15	Wisconsin Legislature commend Stan Pelecky's public service, express their sorrow
16	at his death and extend their condolences to his family and friends; and, be it further
