Young, cosponsored by Senators Grobschmidt, Huelsman, Roessler, Rude and SCHULTZ. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1	Relating to: declaring October 21, 1997, Benefit Specialists Day.
2	Whereas, benefit specialists assist elderly persons in securing the public
3	benefits that they are entitled to; and
4	Whereas, to that end benefit specialists provide information, assistance and
5	representation; and
6	Whereas, these services are provided through county and tribal aging units
7	supported by legal back-up provided through area agencies on aging, and all of these
8	services are coordinated by the Bureau on Aging within the Wisconsin Department
9	of Health and Family services; and
10	Whereas, these invaluable services are provided without charge; and
11	Whereas, benefit specialists deserve recognition for the advocacy that they
12	provide for the elderly persons of this state; and
13	Whereas, the benefit specialists will be assembling for the Aging Network

Training in October of this year; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the legislature of the state of Wisconsin proclaims October 21, 1997, "Wisconsin Benefit Specialists Day".
