1997 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 66

August 19, 1997 - Introduced by Representatives Schneider, Ainsworth, Musser. Gronemus, Plouff, Harsdorf, Sykora and Powers, cosponsored by Senator SCHULTZ. Referred to Committee on State Affairs.

Relating to: requesting a study regarding uniform school calendars and class schedules to facilitate distance learning.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This joint resolution requests the joint legislative council to study and report to the legislature on the feasibility and advisability of implementing uniform school calendars and class schedules in the public schools, the University of Wisconsin System and the technical college system to facilitate distance learning.

Whereas, to facilitate distance learning it may be feasible and advisable for public schools, the University of Wisconsin System and the technical college system to have uniform school calendars and class schedules; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the joint legislative council is requested to study the feasibility and advisability of implementing uniform school calendars and class schedules in the public schools, the University of Wisconsin System and the technical college system and to report its findings, conclusions and recommendations to the 1999 legislature when it convenes.
