## 1997 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 3

February 10, 1997 - Introduced by Representatives Baumgart, Lorge, Baldwin, Black, Dueholm and Kelso. Referred to Committee on Assembly Organization.

**To create** assembly rule 2 (5); **relating to:** open meetings of party caucuses.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This resolution requires most meetings of party caucuses to be open to the public, except those regarding personnel matters of the state or any unit of the state.

## Resolved by the assembly, That:

**Section 1.** Assembly rule 2 (5) is created to read:

Assembly Rule 2 (5) Every meeting of a party caucus which is held on a day of a week during which the assembly is in session, other than on Saturday, Sunday or a legal holiday, and which is conducted in a building owned or leased by the state shall be open to the public, except that a closed meeting may be held to consider or act on issues regarding personnel matters of the state or any unit of the state.
