

## **1997 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 5**

May 15, 1997 – Introduced by Representative SCHNEIDER. Referred to Committee on Assembly Organization.

1 **To create** assembly rule 76 (1m); **relating to:** voting on legislation that increases

2 tax rates and fees.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This resolution prohibits the assembly from passing a bill increasing the rate of a tax, other than a tax on alcohol or tobacco, or increasing a fee unless the bill is approved by two-thirds of the members elected to the assembly.

Resolved by the assembly, That:
SECTION 1. Assembly rule 76 (1m) is created to read:

of a tax, other than a tax on alcohol or tobacco, or increasing a fee unless the bill is
approved by two-thirds of the members elected to the assembly.
