



## 1997 SENATE BILL 34

January 28, 1997 - Introduced by Senators COWLES, RISSER, RUDE, CLAUSING, SCHULTZ and PLACHE, cosponsored by Representatives JOHNSRUD, HUTCHISON, BAUMGART, ALBERS, R. YOUNG, GOETSCH, SERATTI, MUSSER, OLSEN and GRONEMUS. Referred to Committee on Agriculture and Environmental Resources.

1     **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 30.71; *to amend* 30.71 (title); and *to create*  
2           30.71 (1) and 30.71 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** disposal facilities on  
3           outlying waters for toilet wastes from boats and granting rule-making  
4           authority.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, no person may dispose of any toilet wastes from boats that are equipped with toilets into the waters of this state. Under this bill, establishments that provide berths or moorings to 5 or more boats must provide onshore disposal facilities for these toilet wastes. Under the bill, any rules established to carry out this requirement must be jointly promulgated by the department of commerce and the department of natural resources.
