The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 36.25 (23) of the statutes is amended to read:

36.25 (23) Robert M. La Follette institute of public affairs at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. The institute shall engage in research, public service and educational activities to advance the knowledge of public affairs and the application

- of that knowledge to the needs of this state. Beginning in the 2000-01 academic year,
- 2 at least 80% of the courses offered by the institute shall be held after 5 p.m.
