## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

PREFATORY NOTE: This bill was prepared at the request of the joint legislative council's special committee to review the election process.

The bill appropriates funds to increase the authorized full-time equivalent (FTE) positions for the elections board by 1.5 positions funded by general purpose revenue (GPR) for fiscal year 2000–01.

3 SECTION 1. Appropriation changes; elections board.
