## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin System (board) to award a grant of \$2,000 to a resident undergraduate student to assist in paying the costs of study abroad if the student satisfies certain criteria. This bill instead requires the board to award a grant of up to \$2,000.
