## **1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 912**

March 21, 2000 – Introduced by Representatives GROTHMAN, NASS and UNDERHEIM. Referred to Committee on Education Reform.

1 AN ACT *to create* 118.30 (2) (f) of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting pupils 2 from using a calculator while taking the 4th and 8th grade knowledge and 3 concepts examinations.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, each pupil enrolled in a public or charter school in this state must take examinations in the 4th and 8th grades that are designed to measure pupil attainment of knowledge and concepts. This bill prohibits a pupil from using a calculator while taking either examination.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 118.30 (2) (f) of the statutes is created to read:

s. 118.40 (2r), shall ensure that no pupil uses a calculator while taking the 4th or 8th
grade examination under sub. (1m) or (1r).
SECTION 2. Initial applicability.
