7	breaking its own 1998 record by over 1,000 points; and

10	Academic Decathlon National Championship, placing 5th in 1997, 6th in 1998 and
11	3rd in 1999; and

13	standard of excellence for all students in the state of Wisconsin at the 1999 U.S.
14	Academic Decathlon National Championship in Anaheim, California; and

5	spending many hours on weekdays and weekends preparing for the 10 academic
6	tests and demonstrations required by the state competition; and
