## 1999 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 37

March 28, 2000 - Introduced by Representatives JENSEN, FOTI, VRAKAS, DUFF, URBAN, GUNDRUM, JESKEWITZ, GUNDERSON and NASS. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1     **Relating to:** commending Joseph E. Wimmer for his lifelong commitment to public  
2             service and the people of Waukesha, Wisconsin, and the United States.
