### **1999 SENATE BILL 222**

August 26, 1999 – Introduced by Senator Baumgart, cosponsored by Representatives Stone and J. Lehman, by request of Robert Ballschmider. Referred to Committee on Insurance, Tourism, Transportation and Corrections.

- 1 AN ACT to amend 347.50 (1); and to create 347.50 (4m) of the statutes; relating
- 2 **to:** mufflers on motorcycles and providing a penalty.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a person who operates a motorcycle without a functioning muffler may be required to pay a forfeiture of not less than \$10 nor more than \$200. This bill raises the forfeiture for operating a motorcycle without a functioning muffler to not less than \$100 nor more than \$300.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **Section 1.** 347.50 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 347.50 (1) Any person violating ss. 347.35 to 347.49, except s. 347.413 (1) or s.
- 5 347.415 (1), (2) and (3) to (5) or s. 347.417 (1) or s. 347.48 (2m) or (4) (a) or s. 347.486
- 6 (3) or s. 347.489, may be required to forfeit not less than \$10 nor more than \$200.
- 7 **Section 2.** 347.50 (4m) of the statutes is created to read:
- 8 347.50 (4m) Any person violating s. 347.486 (3) may be required to forfeit not
- 9 less than \$100 nor more than \$300.
