## **1999 SENATE BILL 8**

January 20, 1999 - Introduced by Senators GEORGE, BRESKE, DARLING and FITZGERALD, cosponsored by Representatives MUSSER and ZIEGELBAUER. Referred to Committee on Economic Development, Housing and Government **Operations**.

AN ACT to amend 125.68 (4) (a) of the statutes; relating to: hours of sales by 1

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits the premises of a licensed intoxicating liquor wholesaler to be open for the sale of liquor between the hours of 5 p.m. and 8 a.m., except on Saturday the premises may remain open until 9 p.m.

This bill allows these premises to be open for sales until 9 p.m. daily.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3	<b>SECTION 1.</b> 125.68 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	125.68 (4) (a) Wholesalers. No premises for which a wholesale intoxicating
5	liquor permit has been issued may remain open for the sale of intoxicating liquor
6	between the hours of 5 $\underline{9}$ p.m. and 8 a.m. <del>, except on Saturday the premises may</del>
7	<del>remain open until 9 p.m.</del>
