1 AN ACT to amend 74.09 (5) of the statutes; relating to: mailing property tax bills.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires that a taxation district clerk mail property tax bills to taxpayers no later than December 31.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 74.09 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 74.09 (5) Mailing. The No later than December 31, the taxation district clerk or the clerk's designee shall mail the property tax bill to each property taxpayer of the taxation district or the taxpayer's designee. If the property tax bill is mailed to the taxpayer's designee, the designee shall furnish the taxpayer with a copy of the bill.

Section 2. Initial applicability.
