## 2001 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 78

November 27, 2001 - Introduced by Representatives POCAN, BOYLE, MILLER, PLOUFF, RICHARDS, RYBA and SINICKI, cosponsored by Senators MOORE and S. FITZGERALD. Referred to Committee on Corrections and the Courts.

1       **Relating to:** renaming the Supermax Correctional Institution the Tommy G.  
2           Thompson Supermax Correctional Institution.

3           Whereas, Tommy G. Thompson was first elected to public office in 1966 as a  
4       member of the Wisconsin state assembly; and

5           Whereas, Tommy G. Thompson was elected governor of the great state of  
6       Wisconsin in 1986; and

7           Whereas, Tommy G. Thompson was the longest-serving governor in Wisconsin  
8       state history; and

9           Whereas, Tommy G. Thompson created a cabinet-level Department of  
10       Corrections due to the rapidly increasing number of prisoners in Wisconsin; and

11          Whereas, Tommy G. Thompson distinctively proposed and championed the  
12       construction of the Supermax Correctional Institution (SMCI) located in Boscobel,  
13       Wisconsin; now, therefore, be it
