1	Relating to: urging Congress to establish September 11 as National Fire
<b>2</b>	Fighters/Police Officers Day.
3	Whereas, fire fighters and police officers from all over have come to the aid and
4	rescue of those affected by the September 11 tragedy in New York and Washington
5	D.C.; have lost their lives to save someone else's; and truly are heroes; and
6	Whereas, in honor of the bravery, courage, and determination of American fire
7	fighters and police officers on September 11, 2001, and throughout the years, there
8	should be a day in our nation to celebrate and appreciate their hard work and never
9	ending passion for saving lives; now, therefore, be it
10	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the Wisconsin
11	legislature hereby urges Congress to establish September 11 as "National Fire
12	Fighters/Police Officers Day"; and, be it further
13	<b>Resolved, That</b> the assembly chief clerk shall provide a copy of this joint
14	resolution to the president and secretary of the U.S. senate, to the speaker and clerk
15	of the U.S. house of representatives, and to each member of the congressional
