Assembly Rule 7 (4) The committee on assembly organization shall determine the number of assembly employes employees assigned to each member and the type of duties and responsibilities assigned to each employe employee, but may not assign the duty or responsibility of press spokesperson to any employee. A member may not assign the duty or responsibility of press spokesperson to any employee.
