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Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Beginning on July 1, 2004, or the day after publication of this bill as an act, whichever is earlier, this bill requires that patient health care records that are laboratory test reports of hospitals or certified laboratories be printed with a type size that is no smaller than 14 point.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 146.816 of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 **146.816 Format of certain patient health care records.** A patient health
- 5 care record that is a report of laboratory test services of a hospital, as defined in s.
- 6 50.32 (2), or of a laboratory certified under 42 USC 263a shall be printed with a type
- 7 size that is no smaller than 14 point.
