March 18, 2003 – Introduced by Representatives Loeffelholz, Hines, Musser, Hahn, Ladwig, Ainsworth, Townsend, Freese, Bies, Ott, Petrowski, McCormick, Suder and Gronemus, cosponsored by Senator Leibham. Referred to Committee on Agriculture.

- 1 AN ACT to amend 20.866 (2) (s) of the statutes; and to affect 2001 Wisconsin Act
- 2 16, section 9107 (1) (m) 1.; **relating to:** constructing a veterinary diagnostic
- 3 laboratory and granting bonding authority.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases the authorized general fund supported borrowing authority of the state by \$4,900,000 for the purpose of constructing a veterinary diagnostic laboratory located at the University of Wisconsin–Madison. The bill also increases the amount enumerated for the laboratory under the 2001–03 authorized state building program from \$20,000,000 to \$24,900,000.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 20.866 (2) (s) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 5 20.866 (2) (s) University of Wisconsin; academic facilities. From the capital
- 6 improvement fund, a sum sufficient for the board of regents of the University of
- Wisconsin System to acquire, construct, develop, enlarge or improve university
