2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 339

May 13, 2003 – Introduced by Representatives BIES, HINES, JESKEWITZ, LADWIG, F. LASEE and SERATTI, cosponsored by Senator A. LASEE. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

1 AN ACT relating to: limiting the spending of technical college districts during 2 the 2003-05 fiscal biennium.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits a technical college district board from spending, in either the 2003–04 school year or the 2004–05 school year, more than it spent in the 2002–03 school year, excluding debt service on existing debt.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.
 4 (1) In each of the 2003–04 and 2004–05 fiscal years, no technical college district
 5 board may spend more than it spent in the 2002–03 fiscal year, excluding debt service
 6 on debt in existence immediately prior to the effective date of this subsection.
