2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 441

July 21, 2003 – Introduced by Representatives Owens, Kreibich, Hines and Vrakas, cosponsored by Senators Roessler and Risser. Referred to Committee on Public Health.

AN ACT *to amend* 101.123 (1) (ar) of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting smoking in the vicinity of the state capitol building.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits smoking in the immediate vicinity of the state capitol building, as determined by rule of the Department of Administration. Currently, the immediate vicinity of the state capitol building does not include any area that is more than one fathom from the state capitol building.

This bill deletes this prohibition and, instead, prohibits smoking within 25 feet of the state capitol building.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 101.123 (1) (ar) of the statutes is amended to read:

101.123 (1) (ar) "Immediate vicinity of the state capitol" means the area directly adjacent to any location within 25 feet of the state capitol building, as determined by rule of the department of administration. "Immediate vicinity of the
