## 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 449

July 25, 2003 – Introduced by Representatives Hubler, Ott, Miller, Hahn, Lothian and Seratti, cosponsored by Senator Roessler. Referred to Committee on Judiciary.

- 1 AN ACT to create 70.32 (4) of the statutes; relating to: exempting an assessor
- 2 and an assessor's staff from liability for trespassing.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a county surveyor and the surveyor's assistant who are required to subdivide a section or smaller subdivision of land may not be held liable as trespassers and are only liable for any actual damage done to land or property. This bill provides a similar exemption from liability for trespassing for an assessor and the assessor's staff who are engaged in official business.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 70.32 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 70.32 (4) An assessor and an assessor's staff who are engaged in official
- 5 business may not be held liable as trespassers and shall be liable only for any actual
