February 13, 2003 – Introduced by Representatives Turner, Young, Coggs, Berceau, Underheim and Colon, cosponsored by Senators Carpenter and Welch. Referred to Committee on Government Operations and Spending Limitations.

AN ACT to create 13.91 (3) of the statutes; relating to: the employment of a legislative council staff attorney who is fluent in speaking, reading, and writing the Spanish language.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the director of the legislative council staff to hire as the next-hired legislative council staff attorney a person who is fluent in speaking, reading, and writing the Spanish language and to thereafter employ at least one staff attorney with those qualifications.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 13.91 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

13.91 (3) Employment of Spanish-speaking legislative council staff attorney. The director of the legislative council staff shall hire a legislative council staff attorney who is fluent in speaking, reading, and writing the Spanish language before hiring any other legislative council staff attorney after the effective date of
