

2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 66

February 18, 2003 – Introduced by Representatives WASSERMAN, FREESE, HINES, TURNER, ALBERS, BIES and HAHN. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

1 AN ACT *to create* 36.25 (46) of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring all persons 2 admitted to the University of Wisconsin Medical School to take the Medical 3 College Admission Test.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires all persons admitted to the University of Wisconsin Medical School to take the Medical College Admission Test, which assesses mastery of basic concepts in biology, chemistry, and physics; facility with scientific problem solving and critical thinking; and writing.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** 36.25 (46) of the statutes is created to read:
- 5 36.25 (46) MEDICAL COLLEGE ADMISSION TEST. The board shall ensure that all
- 6 persons admitted to the University of Wisconsin Medical School take the Medical
- 7 College Admission Test.
- 8 SECTION 2. Effective date.
