## 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 68

February 18, 2003 – Introduced by Representatives Pettis, Krawczyk, Stone, Van Roy, Hines and Seratti. Referred to Committee on Education.

- 1 AN ACT to create 118.33 (1) (e) of the statutes; relating to: granting high school
- 2 credit for extracurricular sports.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires a high school pupil to earn 1.5 credits in physical education in order to be eligible for a high school diploma. This bill authorizes a school board to grant a pupil credit in physical education for participating in an extracurricular sport if the sport is watched by a person who is licensed to teach physical education.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 118.33 (1) (e) of the statutes is created to read:
- 118.33 (1) (e) A school board may grant a pupil credit in physical education under par. (a) 1. for participating in an extracurricular sport if the sport is watched by a person who is licensed to teach physical education.
- 7 Section 2. Initial applicability.
