AN ACT *to create* 29.053 (1m) of the statutes; **relating to:** closing dates for certain fishing seasons.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current statutory law requires that all fishing seasons on inland waters open on a Saturday. Under rules promulgated by the Department of Natural Resources, many fishing seasons end on March 1, regardless of on which day of the week March 1 falls. This bill requires that a March 1 closing date be interpreted to be the first Sunday following March 1, unless March 1 falls on a Sunday.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 29.053 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:
- 29.053 (1m) Any March 1 closing date set for any fishing season shall be considered to be the first Sunday following March 1 if March 1 does not fall on a Sunday.
