1 AN ACT **relating to:** funding for work-based learning programs and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Workforce Development organizes work-based learning programs for elementary and high school students. These programs help students find postsecondary educational opportunities and give students workplace learning opportunities through apprenticeships. The programs are funded from Indian gaming receipts.

This bill increases the amount of Indian gaming receipts that is appropriated to the Technical College System Board for work–based learning programs.
