2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 813

February 5, 2004 – Introduced by Representatives Stone, Ladwig, Suder, Montgomery, Vukmir, J. Wood and Pettis, cosponsored by Senator Brown. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

1	AN ACT to create 36.09 (2) (c) and 36.09 (3) (c) of the statutes; relating to:
2	prohibiting University of Wisconsin System administrators from serving on the
3	board of directors of certain corporations.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the president of the University of Wisconsin System (UWS), each UWS chancellor, and certain other high-level UWS administrators from serving on the board of directors of corporations with which the UWS is doing business.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 36.09 (2) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

SECTION 2. 36.09 (3) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

36.09 (3) (c) No chancellor or dean of a college campus may serve on the board
of directors of a corporation with which the system, an institution, or a college
campus has a contractual or business relationship.
