2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 835

February 11, 2004 - Introduced by Representative Schneider. Referred to Committee on Small Business.

AN ACT *to create* 175.22 of the statutes; **relating to:** written policies on the use of recording devices in locker rooms.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires any person who owns or operates a locker room in this state to adopt a written policy on the use of recording devices in the locker room.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 175.22 of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 175.22 Policy on the use of recording devices in locker rooms. (1) In this section:
 - (a) "Person" includes the state.
 - (b) "Recording device" means a camera, an audio or video recorder, or any other device that may be used to record or transfer sounds or images.
- 9 **(2)** Any person that own or operates a locker room in this state shall adopt a written policy on the use of recording devices in the locker room.
