2	Whereas, Paul J. Sturino, son of Dino and Christine, was born in Cumberland,
3	Wisconsin, on September 14, 1982; and
4	Whereas, Mr. Sturino attended and graduated from Rice Lake High School,
5	where he excelled in wrestling and was a role model to his fellow classmates; and
6	Whereas, Paul Sturino was an avid outdoorsman and a devoted member of the
7	community; and
8	Whereas, in 2001 Paul Sturino illustrated his devotion to the United States of
9	America by enlisting in the United States Army; and
10	Whereas, Mr. Sturino excelled at advanced training in field artillery and at
11	paratrooper training; and
12	Whereas, Mr. Sturino was deployed to Iraq in March of 2003 to combat
13	terrorism and fight for the freedom of the Iraqi people; and
14	Whereas, Paul J. Sturino died in Iraq while serving the United States of
15	America on September 22, 2003; and

Whereas, Paul J. Sturino honorably represented the people of Rice Lake, the 1 2 people of Wisconsin, and the people of the United States of America; and 3 Whereas, in recognition of his service to this country, Paul J.
