## **2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 1079**

February 28, 2006 – Introduced by Representative Loeffelholz, cosponsored by Senator Schultz, by request of Jim Muench. Referred to Committee on Rural Development.

- 1 **AN ACT** to amend 23.33 (4) (c) (title); and to create 23.33 (4) (c) 3. and 23.33 (11)
- 2 (ag) of the statutes; **relating to:** allowing all-terrain vehicles on highways for
- 3 the purpose of plowing snow.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no person may operate an all-terrain vehicle upon any part of any freeway that is a part of the federal system of interstate and defense highways or upon any part of any other highway except for limited operations such as crossing a highway between trails. There are limited exceptions that allow a person to operate an all-terrain vehicle on a closed highway during a special event or for certain municipal, state, and utility operations.

This bill allows a county, town, city, or village to allow a person to operate an all-terrain vehicle on a highway for the purpose of removing snow. In order to operate an all-terrain vehicle on a highway, a person must have a snowplow attached to his or her all-terrain vehicle and there must be an accumulation of snow on the ground.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 23.33 (4) (c) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

23.33 (11) (ag) A county, town, city, or village may enact an ordinance that allows a person to operate an all-terrain vehicle on a highway for the purpose of removing snow. An ordinance enacted under this subsection may allow the operation of an all-terrain vehicle on a highway only when there is accumulated snowfall on the ground and only if the all-terrain vehicle has an attached snowplow.
