## 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 234

- March 16, 2005 Introduced by Representatives Musser, Bies, Townsend, Nass, Suder, Gronemus, Freese, McCormick, Gundrum and Gunderson, cosponsored by Senators Leibham, Roessler, Hansen and Grothman. Referred to Committee on Veterans Affairs. Referred to Joint Survey Committee on Tax Exemptions.
- 1 AN ACT to create 77.54 (48) of the statutes; relating to: a sales tax exemption
- 2 for sales to veterans organizations.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales tax and use tax exemption for goods and services sold to veterans organizations.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 77.54 (48) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 77.54 (48) The gross receipts from the sale of goods and services to, and the
- 5 storage, use, or other consumption of goods and services by, a state veterans
- 6 organization, as defined in s. 45.353 (1) (b).
- 7 SECTION 2. Effective date.
