Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the Department of Transportation to designate and mark with signs the bridge that crosses the Wisconsin River west of Portage as the "American Revolution Memorial Bridge."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **Section 1.** 84.1034 of the statutes is created to read:
- 84.1034 American Revolution Memorial Bridge. The department shall designate and mark the bridge on I 90 USH 51 across the Wisconsin River as the "American Revolution Memorial Bridge" to commemorate the American Revolutionary War.
