2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 471

June 9, 2005 - Introduced by Representative Schneider. Referred to Committee on Health.

1 AN ACT *to create* 134.85 of the statutes; **relating to:** gender discrimination in prescription drug pricing.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits a person engaged in selling or dispensing prescription drugs from discriminating in price between purchasers of a drug on the basis of the gender of the purchasers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **Section 1.** 134.85 of the statutes is created to read:
- 134.85 Gender discrimination in prescription drug pricing. (1) In this section, "drug" means any substance subject to 21 USC 353(b).
- 6 **(2)** No person who sells or dispenses drugs may discriminate in price between purchasers of a drug on the basis of the gender of the purchasers.
- 8 Section 2. Effective date.
