## 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 777

October 20, 2005 - Introduced by Representatives Gielow, Gronemus, Albers, Berceau, Gottlieb, Krawczyk, Ott, Sheridan, Strachota and Van Roy, cosponsored by Senator Darling, by request of Cheryle Rebholz of Mequon. Referred to Committee on Health.

AN ACT to amend 15.405 (17) of the statutes; relating to: the barbering and cosmetology examining board.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the barbering and cosmetology examining board (board) consists of nine members appointed for four-year terms. The board consists of four members who are licensed barbers or cosmetologists, two public members, one member who is a representative of a private school of barbering or cosmetology, one member who is a representative of a public school of barbering or cosmetology, and one member who is a licensed electrologist.

Under this bill, an aesthetician may serve on the board, but the bill does not change the number of members on the board.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 15.405 (17) of the statutes is amended to read:
15.405 (17) Barbering and cosmetology examining board. There is created a barbering and cosmetology examining board in the department of regulation and licensing. The barbering and cosmetology examining board shall consist of 9
members appointed for 4-year terms. Four members shall be licensed barbers, aestheticians, or cosmetologists, 2 members shall be public members, one member shall be a representative of a private school of barbering or cosmetology, one member shall be a representative of a public school of barbering or cosmetology and one member shall be a licensed electrologist. Except for the 2 members representing schools, no member may be connected with or have any financial interest in a barbering or cosmetology school.
