## 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 854

December 5, 2005 - Introduced by Representatives Suder, Musser, Hines, Townsend and Mursau, Referred to Committee on Tourism.

- 1 AN ACT to create 23.33 (6m) (b) of the statutes; relating to: limits on noise
- 2 emitted from all-terrain vehicles.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no person may manufacture, sell, rent, or operate an all-terrain vehicle that emits noise exceeding 96 decibels on the A scale as measured in a manner prescribed by rules promulgated by the Department of Natural Resources. This bill provides that this noise limit does not apply to an all-terrain vehicle while it is operated on a privately owned raceway facility.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 23.33 (6m) (b) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 23.33 (6m) (b) The noise limit under par. (a) does not apply to an all-terrain
- 5 vehicle while it is operated on a privately owned raceway facility.
