2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 97

February 8, 2005 – Introduced by Representatives AINSWORTH, BALLWEG, HAHN, HINES, MUSSER, NASS, OTT, OWENS, STONE, TOWNSEND and VAN ROY, cosponsored by Senators KEDZIE, COWLES, A. LASEE, OLSEN and STEPP. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

1 AN ACT to repeal 348.185 and 348.21 (1) of the statutes; relating to: displaying

the empty weight on the side of certain motor vehicles.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits any person from operating a motor truck, truck tractor, motor bus, trailer, or semitrailer unless the vehicle's empty weight is displayed on the side of the vehicle. This bill eliminates the requirement that a vehicle's empty weight be displayed.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **SECTION 1.** 348.185 of the statutes is repealed.
- 4 **SECTION 2.** 348.21 (1) of the statutes is repealed.
