- March 19, 2007 Introduced by Representatives MUSSER, PETROWSKI, BIES, TURNER, GRONEMUS, GUNDRUM, SINICKI, OWENS, F. LASEE, HAHN, LOTHIAN, HINES, GUNDERSON and NERISON, cosponsored by Senators BRESKE, LEIBHAM, LAZICH, A. LASEE, OLSEN, DARLING and S. FITZGERALD. Referred to Committee on Veterans and Military Affairs. Referred to Joint Survey Committee on Tax Exemptions.
- 1 AN ACT to create 77.54 (50) of the statutes; relating to: a sales tax exemption

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for sales to veterans organizations.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales tax and use tax exemption for goods and services sold to veterans organizations.

Because this bill relates to an exemption from state or local taxes, it may be referred to the Joint Survey Committee on Tax Exemptions for a report to be printed as an appendix to the bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 77.54 (50) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 77.54 (50) The gross receipts from the sale of goods and services to, and the
- 5 storage, use, or other consumption of goods and services by, a state veterans

6 organization, as defined in s. 45.41 (1) (b).

7 SECTION 2. Effective date.
