2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 344

May 21, 2007 – Introduced by Representatives MURSAU, M. WILLIAMS, STRACHOTA, GUNDERSON, A. OTT, GRONEMUS, VOS, MUSSER, BIES, GARTHWAITE, JESKEWITZ and DAVIS, cosponsored by Senator A. LASEE. Referred to Committee on Education.

1	AN ACT to create 20.255 (2) (fp) of the statutes; relating to: awarding grants to
2	school districts for school district consolidation feasibility studies and making
3	an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides that a consortium of two or more school districts may apply to the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) for a grant to conduct a school district consolidation feasibility study. An applicant for a grant must submit a plan identifying the school districts engaged in the study, the issues the study will address, and how the grant funds will be expended. DPI must give priority to applications that demonstrate prior district attempts to address underlying issues associated with management and operation of school districts' programs.

The bill appropriates \$250,000 in the 2008–09 fiscal year to fund the grants and limits an award to no more than \$10,000 to an applicant in a fiscal year.

13	(a) A consortium of 2 or more school districts may apply to the department for
14	a grant to conduct a school district consolidation feasibility study. The consortium
15	shall submit a plan identifying the school districts engaged in the study, the issues
16	the study will address, and how the grant funds will be expended. A school district
17	may not be a member of more than one consortium.
18	(b) In the 2008–09 school year, the department shall award grants to consortia
19	from the appropriation under section 20.255 (2) (fp) of the statutes, as created by this
20	act. The department may not award more than \$10,000 to any consortium.
21	(c) The department shall give priority to applications that demonstrate prior
22	attempts to address the underlying issues associated with management and
23	operation of the school districts' programs.
