2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 364

- AN ACT *to create* 302.395 of the statutes; **relating to:** charges for inmate telephone use at a jail or house of correction.
 - Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, charges imposed for a telephone call made by a person confined in a jail or house of correction may not exceed the charges that would be imposed for a comparable telephone call made by a person confined in a state prison.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 302.395 of the statutes is created to read:
- 302.395 Charges for inmate telephone use. The charges imposed for a telephone call made by a person confined in a jail or house of correction may not exceed the charges that would be imposed for a comparable telephone call made by a person confined in a state prison.
