## 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 482

August 7, 2007 - Introduced by Representatives Gunderson, Vos, Pridemore, Pope-Roberts, Musser, Kestell, Albers, Bies, Mursau and Townsend, cosponsored by Senators Darling, Lazich and Schultz. Referred to Committee on Education.

AN ACT to create 119.16 (11) of the statutes; relating to: prohibiting the

Milwaukee Public Schools from imposing residency requirements on teachers.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Beginning July 1, 2009, this bill prohibits the Milwaukee Public Schools from requiring, as a condition of employment, that a teacher reside within the school district.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 119.16 (11) of the statutes is created to read:
- 119.16 (11) Residency requirements. (a) In this subsection, "teacher" means any person holding a license or permit issued by the state superintendent whose employment by a school district requires that he or she hold that license or permit.
- (b) The board may not require, as a condition of employment, that a teacher reside within the district.
