1 AN ACT *to create* 973.20 (2) (c) of the statutes; **relating to:** restitution for 2 misappropriation from a cemetery of certain objects that relate to a veteran.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a court may order a person who is convicted of a crime to pay restitution to the victim of the crime. This bill specifies that a court may require a person who is convicted of misappropriating, from a cemetery, an object that indicates that a deceased was a veteran, to reimburse the cost of replacing the object.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 973.20 (2) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

- 4 973.20 (2) (c) If the crime is misappropriation, from a cemetery, of an object that
- 5 indicates that a deceased was a veteran, as described in s. 45.001, reimburse an
- 6 individual, organization, or governmental entity for the cost of replacing the object.
